February Special Item:

- State Highway 16. Received an update on the status of the State Highway 16 corridor.

February Action Items:

- Development Review Policy and Checklist. Adopted a new COMPASS [Development Review Policy](#) and revised Development Review Checklist template. The new policy will replace the previous Development Review Protocol and Fiscal Impact Policy.
- FY2023-2029 TIP. Adopted an [amendment](#) to the FY2023-2029 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add two projects and change the scope of three projects.
- 2023 Idaho Legislative Activity. Received an overview of legislation introduced to date and directed COMPASS staff to oppose HB55 (Highway-User Revenues and Property taxes) and provide input on HB184 (Definition of Congestion Mitigation) to recommend that “data-driven mitigation strategies” be included in the definition of congestion mitigation.
- NARC Board of Directors. Approved the nomination of City of Star Mayor Trevor Chadwick as a candidate for the National Association of Regional Councils (NARC) Board of Directors for 2023-2025. The election will be held June 7, 2023, at the NARC annual meeting in Detroit, MI.

- Safe Streets and Roads for All. Received notice that COMPASS was awarded a Safe Streets and Roads for All planning grant and an overview of next steps to use the funding to develop a regional safety action plan.
- Urbanized Areas and IT Board Policy 4028. Received a status report on 2020 Census urbanized area results and implications to the COMPASS planning area and an update on implementation of Idaho Transportation (IT) Board Policy 4028.
