COMPASS is an organization of local and state governments in Ada and Canyon Counties that is developing a long-range transportation plan, *Communities in Motion 2040*, for the region. This work is overseen by the Board of Directors comprising city, county and highway district elected officials from the two counties. The current plan is called *Communities in Motion 2035* and is available at [www.compassidaho.org](http://www.compassidaho.org). The intent of the plan is to develop a transportation system that meets the growth and desired land uses in our area.

We are currently seeking the public's feedback on potential growth scenarios developed through workshops with 170 local citizens looking out to year 2040.
